## President's Report - Huetteman

- Huetteman was able to retrieve our original founding documents from 12 years ago with the help of the lawyer, and confirmed we are a private operating foundation. As part of that status, we must pay out 5%+ of our income to our membership each year, and we meet that threshold.
- Huetteman presented a list of recommendations, including hiring a tax professional, setting a reserve policy, and providing financial support to board members to attend JCEP
- The association lost money on past conferences due to hotel fees. Is now working with Bates from Helms-Briscoe to negotiate better contracts
- We received the DEI grant last Monday, which is supporting the Monday session by Nia and copies of her new book for all attendees. It also supports Diaz Thursday session on Intercultural Diversity Inventory and survey access for all registrants. We have an approved IRB for Huetteman and Sewell to do follow up surveys to see how registrants apply this learning to their work in 2023.
